In Luke 21:9, Jesus tells us there would be "wars and *commotions.*" However, these problems would only be the first of many to imperil our world.

Here let it be noted that researchers from Texas Tech University published research in August 2022 which indicates that watching and reading too much news can make people mentally and physically sick. Those who check the news frequently greater physical ill-being," the research finds.

The article later goes on to say, "The increasing rate at which novel pathogens are infecting humans means the probability of new pandemics will grow threefold in the next few decades. It is no longer reasonable, therefore, to regard a pandemic as a once-in-atated toward war for thousands of years. In 2003, the New York Times reported that over the past 3 400 years, the world's population has only been at peace for 268 of them. At least 108 million people were killed in wars during the twentieth century. Thus, war in itself is not a sign of the end, because war is a byproduct of sin, and as long as there is sin in the world, there will be wars.

Nevertheless, Jesus gave us other signs to watch for that indicate the world is growing In this era of pandemics, megadroughts, heat waves, massive wildfires, flooding, economic uncertainty, and widespread violence, there's absolutely no question that we see "distress of nations with perplexity" and

When Daniel the prophet was shown a vision of the end times in Daniel, chapter 8, we are told that he was so distressed by what he saw that he fainted and was "sick certain days" (Daniel 8:27).

Die aangewese koning was toe Saul. Maar wie was hierdie Saul? Aanvanklik was daar 'n mooi ligkant: Saul is deur God Self uitverkies om koning van Israel te wees. Hy was jonk en aantreklik; trouens, onder die hele volk was daar niemand so skoon en mooi van aansien soos hy nie. Hy het kop en skouers bó die volk uitgestaan. Hy het 'n pragtige koninklike beeld geslaan. Vroeg in sy jong lewe as koning (30 jaar oud), is hy bewonder en gerespekteer deur die volk.

Samuel het hóm in sy krisis aangetref terwyl hy op soek was na sy vader se donkies. Die velde het oopgelê, geen grensdrade nie, en hulle donkies was weg! Dit was hulle vervoermiddel, hulle pak-esels, waarvan hulle afhanklik was vir hulle lewensbestaan! Dit is so goed om te sê: "My kar is gesteel!" Ons het genoem dat Saul gering was in sy eie oë. Samuel spreek egter God se seën oor hom uit en deel hom mee wat hy alles vir God moes doen. Maar Saul reageer só: "Is ek nie 'n Benjaminiet, uit een van die kleinste van die stamme van Israel, en my geslag die geringste uit al die geslagte van die stam van Benjamin nie? Toe sê Samuel vir hom: *"Het die* HERE behae in brandoffers en slagoffers soos in gehoorsaamheid aan die Stem van die HERE? Kyk, om gehoorsaam te wees is beter as slagoffer, om te luister beter as die vet van ramme. Want wederstrewigheid is 'n sonde van waarsêery, en eiesinnigheid is afgodery en beeldediens. Omdat jy die woord van die HERE verwerp het, het Hy jou as koning verwerp" (1 Sam. 15:22-23). Onthou, God het voorheen vir hom gesê dat hy hom in sy nederige posisie gevind het en hom verhef het om te regeer oor al die twaalf stamme van Israel, maar nou het hy afgewyk van hierdie goeie weg.

Nou hoekom het God hom nie gehelp nie? Hy sou, maar Saul het Hom nie gevra nie! Sien, God gee aan elke mens 'n eie wil. Met ons eie wil sondig ons en is ons persoonlik aanspreeklik; of met ons eie wil keer ons tot God en vra Hom om ons te red, leiding te gee en te help. Dit bly ons keuse! God het niemand 'n zombie gemaak nie. As Saul maar net gekies het om klein en nederig te bly. Laat ons waaksaam wees, want hierdie versoeking kan ons elkeen tref! God sê, en dán doen wat Hy sê, sal ons veilig wees! Ook veral nádat Hy tyd met ons spandeer in ons beproewing. Ons moet n.a.v. Saul se voorbeeld leer dat ons moet luister en doen. Maar as ons nie luister en doen nie, word dit 'n verkeerde lewenstyl wat wegneig van God. En dan verval ons in die hande van Satan! God het gesê: *"En nadat Hy hom (Saul) afgesit het, het Hy Dawid vir hulle verhef as koning, van wie Hy ook gesê en getuig het: Ek het Dawid, die seun van Isai, gevind, 'n man na my hart, wat al My welbehae sal doen"* (Hand.13:22).

Pakistan is an enormous nation, and we are being told country is currently covered by water... One-third of Pakistan has been completely submerged by historic flooding, its climate minister says. Devastating flash floods have washed away roads, homes and crops - leaving a trail of deadly havoc across Pakistan!

Over the past few months, I have written article after article about the droughts that we are currently witnessing all over the planet. Right now, Europe is experiencing the worst drought that it has gone through in at least 500 years, and the rivers are getting so low that "hunger stones" are now being revealed for the first time in centuries...

On this front, too, Europe's rivers are turning up bleak California wells are going dry. Farmers are either paying a premium for water or letting their fields sit empty. And there is growing concern that water exports from the Colorado

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VPRECEDENTED DROUGHT AND FLOODING

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Needless to say, this is having an enormous impact on agricultural production... A situation report from the United Nations stated that nearly 800 000 livestock, a vital food and livelihood source for Pakistanis, have perished amid the monsoon floods. Around 2 million acres of crops and orchards have also been impacted. I expect those numbers will go even higher as the full extent of the damage becomes clear. This is yet another very serious blow to the global food supply, and it means that our rapidly growing food crisis is going to get even worse.

There are areas in Africa that are dealing with unprecedented flooding right now as well. For example, Sudan is in the midst of yet another round of severe floods, even as much of the Horn of Africa struggles with catastrophic drought. The Save the Children Organization says 83 people have died and another 146 000 have been affected by the flooding. Whole villages have been submerged, with nearly 44 000 homes partially or completely destroyed. People living in the Gezira and River Nile states

have requested assistance from the British-based NGO.

Authorities in Sudan have declared a state of emergency in a third of the country's provinces. Central Darfur, South Darfur, and West Darfur also have seen some of the worst impacts. This is what I mean when I say that global weather patterns have gone completely haywire in 2022. Much of the planet is either getting way too much rain or way too little rain.

Let me give you another example. Here in the United States, even as the western half of the country suffers from endless drought, we are witnessing crazy flooding along the Mississippi River... Major flooding across America's heartland will continue for weeks to come as the Mississippi River surges south. The deadly onslaught of rising waters and storms has killed more than two dozen people in Missouri and Illinois. In all, some 7 million people in 15 states were under threat of flooding, according to CNN meteorologists.

So why is this happening? Is someone trying to tell us something? All of this drought

John 3:16 tells us about the hope that God has given us through Jesus Christ: "For God so loved the world, that He gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life." If you have not already done so, I strongly urge you to ask Jesus to be your Lord and Saviour today!

Raak Stil voor die Here...

Daar is tye van rus en tye van chaos in 'n mens se lewe. As ek praat van chaos bedoel ek nie 'n probleem hier of daar nie, maar sommer 'n stortvloed van probleme! Dit kan bestaan uit 'n magdom klein probleempies wat saam 'n massiewe berg vorm, of 'n aantal groot probleme wat nie minder raak nie, maar dikwels net meer.

In tye van groot probleme probeer ons drastiese dinge om alles te hanteer of op te los. Ons maak planne, ons gesels met ons vertrouelinge daaroor, ons kry professionele hulp indien nodig. Ons huil, skep moed, raak depressief, voel beter en huil dan weer.

Omdat mense almal uniek is, gee almal raad oor hoe húlle die probleme sou hanteer en glo my, die raad verskil drasties van een persoon na 'n ander. Naderhand raak ons verward en besluit een dag een ding, net om die besluit die volgende dag te verander.

Omdat ons in 'n kitswêreld lewe, verwag ons ook vinnige oplossings. Dit is emosioneel uitputtend as die oplossings nie kom nie. Dit is 'n afwaartse spiraal wat ons insluk, besig hou en ons tyd steel. Dit benadeel ons denke negatief. Ons sukkel om logies te dink, verloor perspektief en kan ook nie meer die Stem van die Here in ons lewe hoor nie.

Ons maak staat op ménse vir hulp en soos die chaos vermeerder, vervaag die Here in die agtergrond tot op 'n punt waar ons nie meer Bybel lees of bid nie. Dit is juis in tye van groot swakheid dat die Here in ons lewens werk (*"En Hy het vir my gesê: My genade is vir jou genoeg, want My krag word in swakheid volbring" - 2 Kor.* 12:9).

As ons ophou spartel en begin stil raak, sal ons besef dat die antwoord nie by onsself of by ander mense lê nie, maar by die Vader. Omdat ons maar mens is, spartel ons soms om te laat gaan en dit aan die Here oor te laat. Onthou egter, Hy is die Skepper van die heelal, Hy is heeltemal bevoeg om ons elkeen te help, te red, te verlos, liefde te gee, en om ons te vergoed vir wat die vyand by ons weggeneem het.

Hy is die Een wat die stryd namens ons sal stry as ons Hom toelaat.

Kom ons ondersoek 'n paar situasies waarin ons onself mag bevind:

Teleurstelling

Teleurstelling is 'n gevoel wat ons het wanneer ons lewensomstandighede anders uitdraai as die verwagtinge wat ons koester. Almal van ons sal teleurstellings in ons leeftyd ervaar. Selfs mense vir wie ons lief is of wat ons vertrou, kan ons teleurstel.

'n Voorbeeld hiervan is Jesus se teleurstelling in Judas se verraad. Judas het sy liefde aan Jesus bely, maar het Hom tog verraai. Nog 'n voorbeeld is Jakob wat jare vir Laban gewerk het om met Ragel te trou, maar toe word Lea aan hom gegee. Hy moes toe nog veel langer werk om met Ragel te kon trou.

Tydens sulke teleurstellings ontstaan daar dikwels wraak- of wrokgevoelens teenoor die persoon wat ons teleurgestel het. In Romeine 12:19 staan daar: "Moenie julle wreek nie, geliefdes, maar gee plek vir die toorn: want daar is geskrywe: Aan My kom die wraak toe, Ek sal vergeld, spreek die Here."

Dit is baie belangrik om ons seerkry en pyn aan die Here te bely. Gee dit vir Hom. *"Werp al julle bekommernisse op Hom, want Hy sorg vir julle"* (1 Petrus 5:7).

Ons moet hier braaf wees om diegene wat ons teleurgestel het, te vergewe. As dit moeilik is, maak dit 'n saak van gebed. Soms is die teleurstelling so diep en ons so swak, maar met die Here se hulp sal ons dit regkry!

Moet jy dalk jouself vergewe, liewe mens? Deur die kruisdood het Jesus al klaar voor jou probleme en verkeerde keuses te staan gekom en daarvoor gesterf sodat jy vry kan wees.



Is jy vermoeid?

As ons liggaamlik moeg is, kan ons gaan slaap. As ons emosionele rus nodig het, kan ons 'n tyd lank verlof neem. Hoe vind ons rus vir moeilike lewenskwessies wat die dieptes van ons hart aanraak? Raak stil voor die Here. Kom net soos jy is en sonder jouself af in Sy teenwoordigheid. Pak al jou probleme voor Hom uit. Daar is niks wat ons vir Hom kan wegsteek nie. Hy het ons gevorm in ons moederskoot.

In die Teenwoordigheid van die Here is daar rus. Daar word nie van jou verwag om goeie werke of uitermatige godsdienspraktyke na te jaag sodat die Here vir jou iets in ruil daarvoor sal doen nie. In die Teenwoordigheid van die Here kan ons ophou spartel en kan ons geestelike rus vind wat ons sal versterk, al is ons vlees hoe swak. *"Kom na My toe, almal wat vermoeid en belas is, en Ek sal julle rus gee"* (Matt. 11:28).

Voel jy eensaam?

Pynlike gebeure soos dood, egskeiding of verbrokkeling van verhoudings tussen vriende of ouers en kinders kan vir ons as mense groot smart besorg. Voel jy alleen, voel dit asof daar niemand is na wie jy toe kan gaan of wat vir jou omgee in jou tyd van smart nie? Selfs Jesus vra in Matt. 27:46 "My God, my God, waarom het U my verlaat?" In sulke donker tye voel dit of daar geen hoop is nie. Die werklikheid is dat God nooit Sy Seun Jesus verlaat het nie, al het Jesus dit so ervaar. Hoeveel te meer sal ons as mense dan eensaamheid en smart ervaar? Trane bring vir ons

verligting en dan belowe die Here dat Hy ons nooit sal begewe of sal verlaat nie (Hebreërs 13:5).

Soos wat die Vader nooit vir Jesus alleen gelaat het nie sal Hy ons ook nooit alleen laat nie. "...maar julle droefheid sal in blydskap verander" (Joh. 16:20). Die Heilige Gees is ons Trooster in tye van eensaamheid en pyn. Laat Hom toe om jou te troos, "En Ek sal die Vader bid, en Hy sal julle 'n ander Trooster gee om by julle te bly tot in ewigheid" (Joh. 14:16). Omdat die Trooster by ons bly tot in ewigheid, is ons nie werklik alleen nie. Ons hoef nie die Trooster te gaan soek nie, Hy bly in ons!

Ons is maar almal reisigers hier op aarde. Nie een van ons is vrygestel van probleme of pyn nie. Kom ons wees barmhartig teenoor mekaar, vol medelye en nie haastig om te oordeel nie. Ons sien soms nie die hele pad wat 'n ander persoon stap nie. Wees teer met die onervare jongelinge, medelydend met die oues van dae, simpatiek met die armoediges en sukkelaars, verdraagsaam teenoor die wat swak is en die sondaar en oortreder... Een of ander tyd in jou lewe sal jy ook ander se medelye nodig kry.

Kom ons raak stil voor die Here en betree Sy rus wat alle verstand te bowe gaan. Dit is die een plek waar jy eerlik kan wees, niemand hoef te beïndruk nie en net jouself kan wees. Lê jou pyn, vrese, teleurstellings en ander gevoelens voor die voete van die Here. Hy verstaan en wag vir jou! -BJR

Niks is so erg dat ons nie vergifnis daarvoor kan ontvang nie. Bely nou jou teleurstelling en jou eie sonde voor die Here, Sy genade is vir jou genoeg (2 Korinthiërs 12:9).



SUFFERING FOR CHRIST?

RUSHED, overwhelmed, devastated, torn - these waves of feelings wash over those who suffer, obliterating hope and threatening to destroy them.

Suffering has many forms - physical abuse, debilitating disease, social ostracism, persecution. The pain and anguish tempt a person to turn back, to surrender, to give in.

Many first-century followers of Christ were suffering and being abused and persecuted for believing in and obeying Jesus. Beginning in Jerusalem at the hands of their Jewish brothers, the persecution spread to the rest of the world - wherever Christians gathered.

It climaxed when Rome determined to rid the Empire of the "Christ-ones" - those who would not bow to Caesar.

Peter knew persecution firsthand. Beaten and jailed, he had been threatened often. He had seen fellow-Christians die and the Church scattered. But he knew Christ, and nothing could shake his confidence in his risen Lord.

So Peter wrote to the Church scattered and suffering for the faith - giving comfort and hope, and urging continued loyalty to Christ.

Peter begins by thanking God for salvation. He explains to his readers that trials will refine their faith. They should believe in spite of their circumstances; for many in past ages believed in God's plan of salvation, even the prophets of old who wrote about it but didn't understand it. But now salvation has been revealed in Christ. In response to such a great salvation, Peter commands them to live holy lives, to reverently fear and trust God, to be honest and loving, and to become like Christ.

Jesus Christ, as "the living Cornerstone" upon Whom the Church is to be built, is also the Stone that was rejected, causing those who are disobedient to stumble and fall. But the Church, built upon this Stone, is to be God's royal priesthood.

Next, Peter explains how believers should live during difficult times. Christians should be above reproach, imitating Christ in all their social roles - masters and servants, husbands and wives, church members and neighbours. Christ should be our model for obedience to God in the midst of great suffering.

Peter then outlines the right atti-

tude to have about persecution. Expect it, be thankful for the privilege of suffering for Christ, and trust God for deliverance.

Next, Peter gives some special instructions. Elders should care for God's flock, younger men should be submissive to those who are older, and everyone should trust God and resist Satan.

When you suffer for doing what is right, remember that following Christ is a costly commitment. When persecuted for your faith, rejoice that you have been counted worthy to suffer for your Lord. He suffered for us; as His followers, we should expect nothing less. As you read 1 Peter, remember that trials will come to refine your faith. When they come, remain faithful to God.

but it is likely that God will keep you poor, because He wants you to have something far better than gold, namely, a helpless dependence upon Him, so that He may have the privilege of supplying all your needs day by day out of an unseen treasury.

The Lord may let others be honoured and put forward, and keep you hidden in obscurity, because he wants to produce some choice fragrant fruit for His coming glory, which can only be produced in the shade. He may let others be great, but keep you small.

He may let others do a work for Him and get the credit for it, but He will make you work and toil on without people knowing how much you are doing. Then to make your work still more precious, He may let others get credit for the work which you have done, and thus make your reward ten times greater when Jesus comes.

The Holy Spirit will put a strict watch over you, with a jealous love, and will rebuke you for



little words and feelings or for wasting your time, which other Christians never feel distressed over.

So make up your mind that God is an infinite Sovereign God with a mind of His own.

CAMINOS/SP IN 2005:

She responded: "Only if He (God) travels

in the boot, 'coz inside here it's already full."

Hours later, news came that they had been involved in a fatal accident. Everyone had died. The type of car could not even be recognized, but surprisingly, the boot was still intact! The police said that there was no way that the boot could have remained intact. To their surprise, inside the boot was a crate of eggs, and not one was broken!

-THE HORDES OF HELL ARE MARCHING!

he demonic army was so large that it stretched as far as I could see. It was separated into divisions, with each carrying a different banner. The foremost divisions marched under the banners of Pride, Selfrighteousness, Respectability, Selfish Ambition, Unrighteous Judgment, and Jealousy.

There were many more of these evil divisions beyond my scope of vision, but those in the vanguard of these terrible hordes from hell seemed to be the most powerful. The weapons carried by this horde were also named. The swords were named Intimidation; the spears were named Treachery; and the arrows were named Accusation, Gossip, Slander and Faultfinding.

Scouts and smaller companies of demons with such names as Rejection, Bitterness, Impatience, Unforgiveness, and Lust were sent in advance of this army to prepare for the main attack.

These smaller companies and scouts were much fewer in number, but they were no less powerful than some of the larger divisions that followed. They were smaller only for strategic reasons. Just as John the Baptist was a single man, but was given an extraordinary anointing for baptizing the masses to prepare them for the Lord, these smaller demonic companies were given extraordinary evil powers for "baptizing the masses".

A single demon of Bitterness could sow his poison into multitudes of people, even entire races or cultures.

A demon of Lust would attach himself to a single performer, movie, or even advertisement, and send what appeared to be bolts of electric slime that would hit and "desensitize" great masses of people. All of this was to prepare for the great horde of evil which followed.

This army was marching specifically against the Church, but it was attacking everyone that it could. I knew that it was seeking to pre-empt a coming move of God, which was destined to sweep masses of people into the Church.

The primary strategy of this army was to cause division on every possible level of relationship - churches with each other, congregations with their pastors, husbands and wives, children and parents, and even children with each other. The scouts were sent to locate the openings in churches, families or individuals that Rejection, Bitterness, Lust, etc. could exploit and make larger.

Then the following divisions would pour through the openings to completely overcome their victims.

The most shocking part of this vision was that this horde was not riding on horses, but primarily on Christians! Most of them were well-dressed, respectable, and had the appearance of being refined and educated, but there also seemed to be representatives from almost every walk of life. These people professed Christian truths in order to appease their consciences, but they lived their lives in agreement with the powers of darkness!

It was clear that the power of the demons was rooted almost entirely in the power of deception, and <u>they had deceived</u> <u>these Christians</u> to the point where they could use them and they would think that they were being used by God!

This was because banners of Self-righteousness were being carried by almost all of the individuals so that those marching, could not even see the banners that marked the true nature of these divisions.

As I looked far to the rear of this army I saw the entourage of the Accuser himself. I began to understand his strategy, and I was amazed that it was so simple. He knows that a house divided cannot stand, and this army represented an attempt to bring such division to the Church that she would completely fall from grace.

It was apparent that the only way Satan could do this was to use Christians to war against their own brethren, and that is why almost everyone in the forward divisions were Christians, or at least professing Christians.

Every step that these <u>deceived</u> believers took in obedience to the Accuser, strengthened his power over them. This made his confidence and the confidence of all his commanders grow with the progress of the army as it marched forward.

THE END OF CASH IS ON THE HORIZON

n recent years, people around the world have taken a growing interest in a new form of money known as cryptocurrency. This type of money, which is entirely digital and not backed by any central bank, tends to rise and fall dramatically. Despite its wild swings in value, a growing contingent of people view it as the future of money. Thus, we have seen cryptocurrency exchange websites heavily, advertised on both television and the Internet as efforts are made to propel cryptocurrency into mainstream society. These efforts include endorsements by several professional athletes, including National Football League quarterback Tom Brady, who starred in a commercial for the cryptocurrency exchange website FTX last year.

NFL wide receiver Odell Beckham Jr. made headlines in 2021 when he announced that his entire salary of 750 000 dollars would be paid in the world's most wellknown cryptocurrency, bitcoin. Meanwhile, New York City's new mayor, Eric Adams, announced in January 2022 that his first pay cheque would be converted into cryptocurrency. "New York is the centre of the world, and we want it to be the centre of cryptocurrency and other financial innovations," Adams declared.

Governments generally dislike cryptocurrencies, such as bitcoin, because these currencies are unregulated, anonymous, and seen as competitors to money issued by central banks. In an effort to compete with cryptocurrencies, some countries have already begun to roll out digital currencies of their own. This includes China, which has developed a digital yuan. Under this system, transaction data is anonymous to other currency users and invisible to the banks that conduct the transactions, but fully visible to the Chinese Government. Thus, the authorities in China can track every transaction conducted with the digital yuan and can confiscate money or restrict the flow of funds at will.

The new currency works hand-inhand with China's recently implemented social credit system, which assigns a "social credit score" to Chinese citizens based on their behaviour. For example, playing video games excessively or jaywalking on public streets can lower a person's score, while government-approved activities can raise the score. Those who commit too many infractions can be banned from owning property, taking out loans, or purchasing airline tickets, amongst many other limitations.

It is easy to see the many ways a central-bank-controlled digital currency could become a privacy nightmare. Nevertheless, the Federal Reserve in the United States has been hard at work researching a digital dollar. In Feb. 2022, it was reported that the branch of the Federal Reserve in Boston, in partnership with the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT), is already testing designs for a new digital dollar processing system. The new system is able to process 1.7 million transactions per second. "It is critical to understand how emerging technologies could support a CBDC (central bank digital currency) and what challenges remain. This collaboration between MIT and our technologists has a scalable **CBDC** research model that allows us to learn more about these technologies and the choices that should be considered when designing a CBDC," said Jim **Cunha, Executive Vice-president** and Interim Chief Operating Officer at the Boston Federal Reserve.

In March 2022, American President Joe Biden issued an executive order directing the American Government to focus new attention on cryptocurrencies. The order calls on the **Treasury Department to develop** policy recommendations on protecting consumers, investors, and businesses from the risks associated with unregulated digital currencies. More telling, the order declares that the **President of the United States is** "placing urgency" on the research and development of a digital dollar. These developments indicate that it is no longer a question of IF a digital dollar will be developed but WHEN a digital dollar will be developed. Here let it be noted that 87 countries around the world are in the process of researching and developing central bank digital currencies.

In Aug. 2021, the think tank known as the Brookings Institution published a piece with a headline declaring, "Cash will soon be obsolete. Will America be ready?" The article then urges the Federal Reserve to create a digital dollar. "The United States should develop a digital dollar, not because of what other countries are doing, but because the benefits of a digital currency far outweigh the costs," author Eswar Prasad insists. These purported benefits include providing the poor and those without a bank account access to digital transactions.

The article also suggests that a digital dollar would allow the government to disburse stimulus payments quickly and efficiently to all Americans. The Federal Reserve could use the digital dollar as a tool to impose *negative interest rates* during poor economic conditions. *"If cash were replaced with a digital dollar, however, the Fed could impose a negative interest rate by gradually shrinking the electronic*

balances in everyone's digital currency accounts, creating an incentive for consumers to spend and for companies to invest." I suspect most Americans would resent the Federal Reserve surreptitiously stealing money from their accounts, but that could easily happen when a digital dollar is introduced.

The article does admit that there are some risks involved with implementing a central bank digital currency. "Even with protections in place to ensure confidentiality, no central bank would forgo the ability to audit and trace transactions. A digital dollar could threaten what remains of anonymity and privacy in commercial transactions - a reminder that adopting a digital dollar is not just an economic but also a social decision." In other words, the author believes that the American people should surrender their financial privacy for the good of society. "The end of cash is on the horizon, and it will have far-reaching effects on the economy, finance, and society... With proper preparation and open discussion, we should embrace the advent of a digital dollar."

With so many countries now developing central bank digital currencies, I strongly suspect that these various digital monetary systems could eventually be merged into one, thus producing a global cashless society. This cashless society would become part of a worldwide economic system that seeks to unite the entire world under a global antichrist government. It is very possible that the world's population could find themselves unable to buy or sell without using digital currency.

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
